1D SBCCC 700.1 Audited Courses

(a) Definition. "Audit" means to enroll in a course section without receiving a grade,

academic credit, continuing education unit, or certificate of completion. Students shall

pay to audit courses consistent with the provisions of 1E SBCCC Subchapter 1000.

(b) Eligibility to Audit. A student may audit a course section only on a space available

basis as determined by the college. A student who audits a course section shall not

displace students enrolling or registering to receive a grade, academic credit,

continuing education unit or certificate of completion in the course section. The student

must receive approval to audit a course section consistent with the college's local

procedures.

(c) Local Policy. Students approved to audit course sections must comply with local

college policies related to auditing courses. Colleges may adopt policies and

procedures identifying courses available and not available for audit.

(d) Transcript. The college shall specify on a student's transcript if a student audited a

course section.
