1D SBCCC 800.5 Courses Listed in High School to Community College Articulation

Agreements

(a) The North Carolina High School to Community College Articulation Agreement is an

agreement between the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction and the

North Carolina Community College System. The articulation agreement ensures that

when a student is proficient in a high school course included in the agreement, the

student can receive college credit for that course at any North Carolina community

college.

(b) Colleges shall award credit to students who have completed a high school course

and met the criteria as outlined in the High School to Community College Articulation

Agreement.

(c) A college may award credit for successful completion of other high school courses

consistent with any local high school to community college articulation agreements

entered into by the college and an education entity providing secondary education.
